Motion carried unam.


Motion by Mr. Dominick that Mr. James V. Thompson be hired as part time Dog Catcher at salary of \$35.00 weekly.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAURENS

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAURENS ENABLING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS WITH NON-RESIDENTS OF THE CITY OF LAURENS TO PROVIDE FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE TO THEM.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Laurens, South Carolina, in Council duly assembled, that the Fire Department of the City of Laurens may, from time to time, enter into contracts with persons living, dwelling and residing outside of the City of Laurens whereby the Fire Department of the City of Laurens will provide fire protection to properties lying outside of the corporate limits of the City, for which service the City shall charge a reasonable fee.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAURENS

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAURENS AMENDING SECTION 16-130 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LAURENS, SOUTH CAROLINA, RELATING TO PARKING AND THE REGULATION THEREOF.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Laurens, South Carolina, in Council duly assembled, that Section 16-130, Chapter 16, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Laurens, South Carolina, is hereby amended to read as follows:

- a) It shall be unlaw to park any motor vehicle in the City for a time exceeding two (2) hours in any area where signs have been erected limiting parking to a period not to exceed two (2) hours.
- b) Violations of the foregoing Section shall be punishable by fine of Two and 00/100 (\$2.00) Dollars, and in the event of nonpayment of a Two and 00/100 (\$2.00) Dollar fine within forty-eight (48) hours from notice thereof having been given to the driver of the said vehicle, Summons and Notice of the fine shall be served upon the driver of said vehicle, or the registered owner thereof, and the fine shall be increased to Four and 00/100 (\$4.00) Dollars.
