The motion was rescinded.

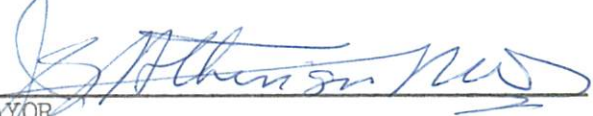
Motion by Mr. Mills that the City re-zone N. Harper St. to Neighborhood Shopping to the City Limits.
