Meeting called by Mayor Medlock.

Present-Mayor Medlock-Aldermen-Brownlee-Davis-Smith-Stoddard-Dendy.

Mr.Dendy makes motion that Mr.Hugh Benson be appointed on the park and recreation committee ~~taxpayers~~ motion carried.Second by Mr.Stoddard.

Motion made by Mr.Stoddard,second by Mr.~~Brownlee~~ Davis requesting the park and recreation committee to proceed with the old hospital and fix it up quickly as possible, motion acrried.

Motion made by Mr.Stoddard,second by Mr.Brownlee that contract be given to A.T.Sistare for construction of roads on Church,Camp,Watts,Garrett and Earle Streets; and Mayor Medlock have authority to sign contract, Sistare being low bidder with a bid of \$3600.00,motion carried.

Motion made by Mr.Davis that six parking places on West Laurens Street be given Taxi Cabs,provided that they do not make turns on the property of Mr.J.L.Davenport and Mr.Holman;and also that alley known as Court Street be given and also that all Taxi Cabs be required to unload in alley known as ~~Sturt~~ Sreet;Second by Mr.Smith.

Mr.Davis makes motion that Mr.J.L.Davenport be appointed to Civil Service Commission of The City of Laurens for a period of three(3) years,second by Mr.Stoddard,to take the place of Mr.Fred W.Taylor whose term expires on April 18,1951-Motion carried.

Mr.Smith wishes to be recorded his vote negative because he made motion that Mr.Taylor be reappointed and failed to get a second.

Upon the request of Mr.Stoddard the Mayor appoints a committee to meet with the board of trustees of Laurens High School to discuss the possibility of construction of a road to relieve the hazard of unloading school children.He appoints Mr.Brownlee,Mr.Stoddard and Mr.Smith.

Mr.Smith makes motion that meeting adjour-second by Mr.Stoddard and so ordered.
