

REGULAR MEETING
 COMMISSION OF PUBLIC WORKS
 April 11, 1966 7:30 P.M.

Present: Chairman Shell, Com. Brownlee, Com. Mauldin, Mr. Bailey Williams, Mr. Brook Blakley, Mr. Danny McNeil, Mr. J. Bendenbaugh. The Secretary led in prayer. The minutes of the Regular meeting of March 14, 1966 were read and approved.

Chairman Shell called the meeting to order and recognized Mr. Bailey Williams. Mr. Williams stated that he had a complaint about the commission policy of penalties. He explained his position concerning the penalty which was imposed upon him because of late payment. His bill was due on the 25th and he paid the bill on the 26th of March.

Chairman Shell recognized Mr. Blakley and asked about water for the Bendenbaugh building. This building is outside the city limits.

Mr. Smith was instructed to continue giving Mrs. Bolt of the Credit Bureau information on addresses and determine the time involved.

Chairman Shell presented a request for sewer service for the Kar Kare Clinic and the Lowery Liquor Store; the approx. cost \$1,983.00.

Motion by Com. Mauldin that the above request be received as information pending receipt of survey now being made.

Mr. Liston was instructed to write a letter to Mr. Otis Mills explaining the commission position.

Mr. Liston reported that the painting of the water tanks was completed and that the work had been O.K'd by the engineer and that the contractor had been paid.

Mr. Liston reported that Mr. J. R. Adair had ^{not} executed contract with the Commission for installation of 500' sewer and 600' water line in his sub division off W. Main St.

Mr. Liston brought up the septic tank pumping policy. Mr. Liston presented a proposed policy for septic tank pumping.

Motion by Com. Brownlee that the policy for pumping septic tanks be adopted.
 Seconded by Com. Mauldin
 Motion carried unan. copy of policy attached.

Motion by Com. Mauldin that Chairman Shell be authorized to execute agreement for municipal pipe line to R. R. with Atlantic Coast Line R. R. Co.

Seconded by Com. Brownlee
 Motion carried unan.
