APRIL 17, 1984

PRESENT: Mayor Dominick, Council members Cox, Crabtree, Franks, Garrett, Henderson, Stewart and Administrator Willett.

The minutes of the March 20, 1984, minutes were amended and approved. On a motion by Mr. Franks and seconded by Mr. Garrett, Council voted 5-2 to include the letter from Mr. Blan Roper concerning an audit for tires and related services. Mr. Crabtree and Mr. Stewart voting against.

On a motion by Mr. Franks and seconded by Mr. Garrett, Council voted 6-1 to approve on second reading an ordinance selling the City's share of the old city parking lot. Mr. Henderson voting against. Ordinance No. 84-3-2.

On a motion by Mr. Franks and seconded by Mr. Stewart, Council voted 6-1 to approve on second reading an ordinance selling a piece of property near the intersection of Mill and Fleming to Mr. W.T. Saylor. Mrs. Cox voting against.

On a motion by Mr. Crabtree and seconded by Mr. Henderson, Council voted 6-1 to purchase three (3) police cars. Mayor Dominick voting against.

Mrs. Cox asked that the city secure prices for carpeting the offices of City Hall and the dispatchers office at the Police and Fire Station.

On a motion by Mr. Henderson and seconded by Mr. Crabtree, Council unanimously reappointed Mr. Joe B. Medlock to the Civil Service Commission.

On a motion by Mr. Stewart and seconded by Mr. Franks, Council unanimously appointed Mr. Jeff Smith and Mr. Bill Hendrix to the Fire Appeals Board.
