He stated that he had quite a problem with water and would appreciate the street committee looking into this situation and would appreciate any consideration given him in this matter.

Mayor Griggs recognized Mr. Jim Milam who stated that he would like to request the city to do something about the water going over his daughters lot on Linden St. This problem was discussed and Mayor Griggs asked the street committee to look into this matter.

Mayor Griggs read a petition from Mrs. Josie Bryson requesting that her property off 76 By-Pass be brought into the city.

Motion by Ald. Hamrick that the city accept the petition and that the property described be accepted into the City.

Seconded by Ald. Strange.

Motion carried unam.

Motion by Ald. Hamrick that the recreation committee working with the Y.M.C.A. be authorized to expend up to \$3,000.00 to repair the Lamar Smith Youth Center. Also if more funds are needed that the committee come back to Council with additional request.

Seconded by Ald. Ed. Armstrong.

Motion carried unam.

Motion by Ald. Hamrick that City Council go on record approving the Bond Issue for the construction of a new Court House.

Seconded by Miss Edwards.

Carried unam.

COMMISSION OF PUBLIC WORKS  
APRIL 14, 1969 7:30 P. M.

Present: Chairman Shell, Com. Brownlee, Com. Barbery, Mgr. Wallace, Mrs. Mary Moore, and Mrs. Margaret Williams.

Chairman Shell called the meeting to order and the Secretary led in prayer.

The minutes of the regular meetings of Feb. 10, 1969, and March 10, 1969 and the planning meetings of Feb. 24, 1969 and March 24, 1969 were read and approved.

Motion by Com. Brownlee that Chairman Shell be authorized to execute on behalf of the Commission a right-of-way agreement with ACLRRCo.  
Seconded by Com. Barbery.  
Motion carried.

Motion by Com. Barbery that the Commission enter into contract with Spartan Const. Co. to install a 12" water main from the water tank at Wattsville to the proposed industrial site on U. S. 221 at a cost of \$103,147.20.  
There being no second, Chairman Shell relinquished the chair to the Secretary for the purpose of making a second to the motion.  
Motion carried.

Motion by Com. Barbery that customers be charged for time and material when taping water lines for fire protection purposes.  
Seconded by Com. Brownlee.  
Motion carried unam.

Motion by Com. Barbery that installation of outdoor private lighting, other than regular pole line construction, if approved be done on a cost of time and material basis.  
Seconded by Com. Brownlee.  
Motion carried unam.

Motion by Com. Barbery that employees of the Commission who have reached the age of 65 years may be retained in the Commission employ under the following conditions:  
Provided that their services are required and they are physically capable of rendering these services, or that the employee is working on a program that is already in progress.  
Provided further that a one year contract be entered into between the Commission and the employee which provides that either party may end the contract upon 30 day written notice.  
Seconded by Com. Brownlee.  
Motion carried unam.

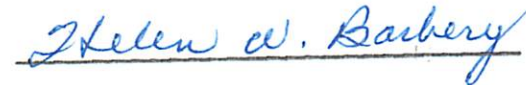
