

MINUTES
LAURENS CITY COUNCIL
APRIL 16, 1985

PRESENT: Mayor Dominick, Council members Bolt, Cox, Franks, Garrett, Henderson, Stewart and Administrator Willett.

The minutes of the March 19, 1985, meeting were approved.

Mrs. Mary Welborn, Director of the Laurens County Pride of the Piedmont Jubilee, gave a report of festival activities and gave each member of Council some Jubilee souvenirs.

Mr. Robbie Armstrong of the YMCA gave a report on spring and summer recreational activities sponsored by the city.

On a motion by Mr. Henderson and seconded by Mr. Bolt, Council passed 6-1 on second reading an ordinance amending the business license rate for wholesale grocers. Mr. Franks voted against.

On a motion by Mr. Stewart and seconded by Mrs. Cox, Council voted unanimously to approve on second reading an ordinance to remove a certain piece of property owned by Mr. Wayne Strange from the City of Laurens.

On a motion by Mr. Franks and seconded by Mr. Stewart, Council voted unanimously to go into executive session to discuss a personnel matter. Upon returning, on a motion by Mr. Bolt and seconded by Mr. Stewart, Council voted 6-1 in favor of confirming Mr. Joe Sumerel as the new Fire Chief. Mr. Franks voting against.

On a motion by Mr. Franks and seconded by Mr. Stewart, Council voted 4-3 to not help the CPW with the expense of running an electric line to the Press Box at the lower field of Jamie Pennell Park. The cost would have been \$825.00. Mrs. Cox, Mr. Franks, Mr. Garrett, and Mr. Stewart in favor - Mr. Bolt, Mayor Dominick and Mr. Henderson voting against.

On a motion by Mr. Garrett and seconded by Mr. Henderson, Council voted 5-2 to pay \$500.00 towards the running of an electric line to the Press Box at the lower field of Jamie Pennell Park. Mr. Franks and Mr. Stewart voting against.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
