



MINUTES OF A COUNCIL MEETING
OF THE COUNCIL, OF THE CITY OF
LAURENS, SOUTH CAROLINA, ON THE
21 DAY OF APRIL, 1950

The Council, of the City of Laurens, South Carolina,
met in special session at the City Hall in said city on 21st
day of April, 1950, at 7:30 o'clock, P.M. The meeting
was called to order by the Mayor and upon roll call the following
members were present: W. P. Dagnall, D. L. Dandy, S. F. Watts,
J. P. Roberts, Sam Reid / and Sam Stoddard. Absent: none.

The following resolution was introduced by Mr. Watts,
who moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, The Housing Authority of the City of Laurens, South Carolina,
is applying to the Public Housing Administration in accordance with the
provisions of the United States Housing Act of 1937, as amended, for a
Preliminary Loan in the amount of \$ 150,000.00, to cover the costs of

approximately 400 dwelling units of low-rent public housing; and

WHEREAS, there exists in the City of Laurens a need for
such low-rent public housing at rents within the means of low-income
families, especially families of living or deceased veterans and service-
men, which need is not being met by private enterprise; and

WHEREAS, such a condition constitutes a menace to the health, safety,
morals and welfare of the inhabitants of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
LAURENS, SOUTH CAROLINA:

That the City Council of the City of Laurens does
hereby approve the Application of the Housing Authority of the City of
Laurens, S. C., to the Public Housing Administration for a Preliminary
Loan in an amount not to exceed \$ 150,000.00, to cover the costs of
surveys and planning in connection with the development of not to exceed
approximately 400 dwelling units of low-rent public housing in the
City of Laurens, South Carolina; and does hereby declare its intent to
enter hereafter into an agreement with said Housing Authority for the
local cooperation by the City in the provision of said low-rent public
housing which may be required by the Public Housing Administration pursuant
to the United States Housing Act of 1937, as amended.


WHEREAS, such a condition constitutes a menace to the health, safety, morals and welfare of the inhabitants of the City;
