We would advise that there will be \$110,000.00 available with the Bond Commission for sewer extensions after completion of the work now in progress.

At your request we are giving you as follows a list of sewer extensions, by areas, which have been surveyed and on which work would be started within a short time:

Peden Construction Co. of Greenville, S. C. the Contractor who is now installing the sewers on Clemson St. would probably accept, at the same low unit prices, additional work in Laurens and could start construction immediately. Otherwise it would be necessary to advertise for bids and then make a contract award, which would require about two months before construction work could start.

	Estimated cost	\$13,421.00


The above prices are estimates of our engineers, Wiedeman and Singleton, of Atlanta, Ga. and may run higher or lower, depending upon certain conditions.
